Scholarship Committee By-Laws

Article I - Name

The name of this committee is the Scholarship Committee (SC)

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of the Scholarship Committee is to review, deliberate and match commendable scholarship recipients with available awards.

Article III - Members

- 1. The Scholarship Committee shall be a committee comprised of three tenure track faculty members elected by SOAAD in addition to the assistant dean who is an ex-officio member.
- 2. The membership and by-laws of the Scholarship Committee should be annually reaffirmed during the first spring meeting by simple majority vote.
- 3. The committee members will serve a two-year term.
- 4. The assistant dean is an ex officio member and is not eligible to vote.

Article IV – Scholarship Committee Chair

- 1. The Scholarship Committee shall be chaired by a tenured track faculty member elected by simple majority vote.
- 2. Elections of the Scholarship Committee chair will be held at the end of the current Chairs term and will be chosen from members who are serving in their first year.
- 3. The chair will serve for a one-year term.
- 4. The committee Chair shall announce dates of meetings at least one week prior to the meeting.
- 5. It is the Chair's responsibility to ensure that the meetings are conducted according to the by-laws.

Article V: Meetings

1. The Scholarship Committee should meet at least once during the spring semester during the regular academic year, additional meetings as necessary.
