<input type="checkbox"/>	GRE Score Report – Request that your scores be sent electronically to KSU (school code 5359). No department code is necessary. Minimum Quantitative score = 160.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Resume - Can be uploaded into the online application.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Statement of how this degree facilitates your career goals – Can be uploaded into the online application.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Three (3) Letters of Recommendation - Can be sent electronically through the online application. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least one from an academic source• One preferred from a source outside the academic community
<input type="checkbox"/>	Successful completion of Math courses through Calculus II
<input type="checkbox"/>	Base SAS Certification preferred
