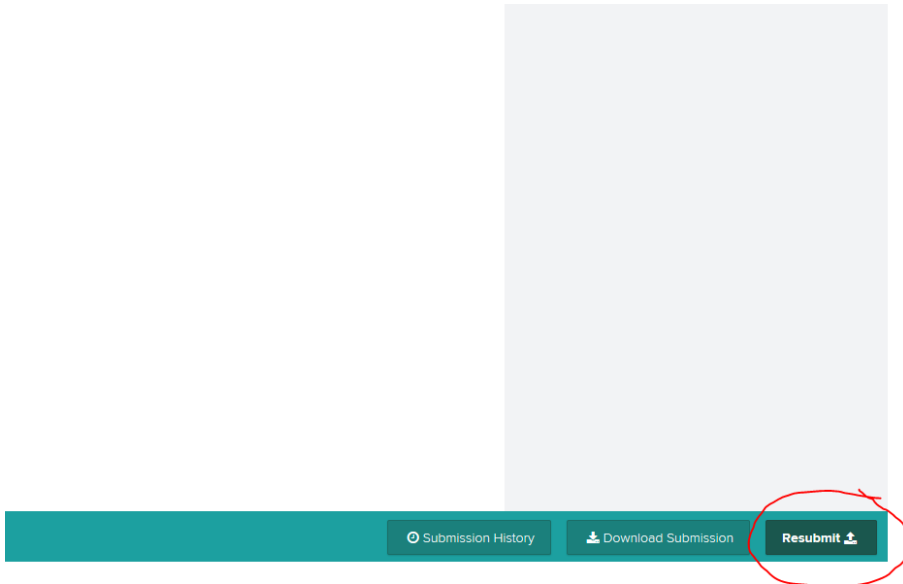
3. From there click on the assignment and it will take you to another screen and not the same pop-up menu that appeared when you had no submission.
