


We've Moved!

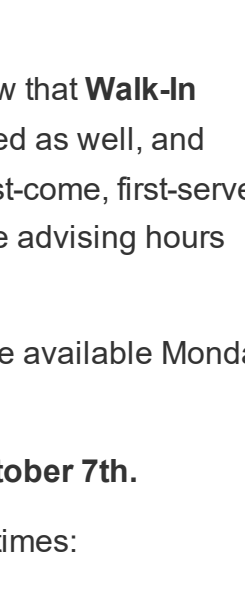

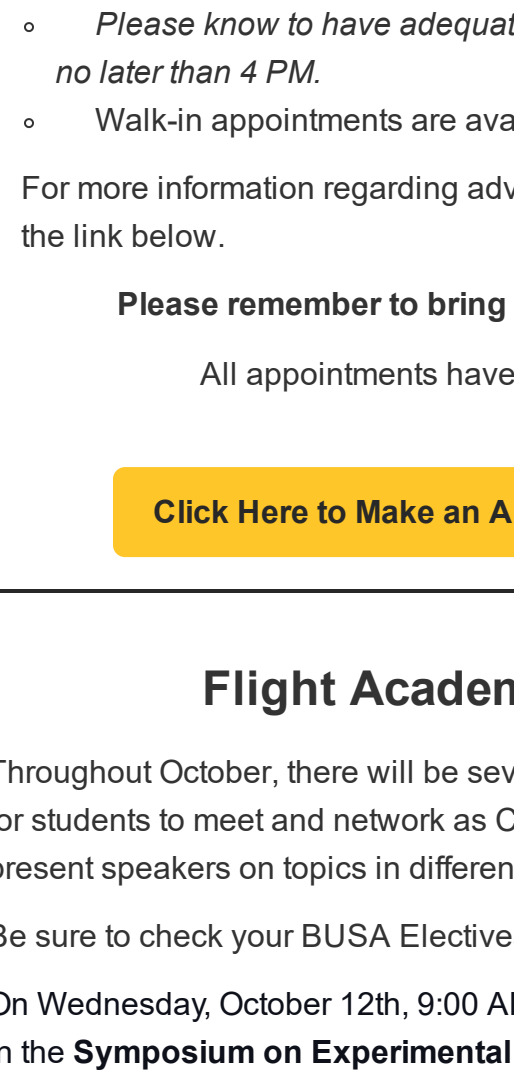
Engaged Alumni Keynote Series

Be sure to check your BUSA Electives for upcoming events!


On **Wednesday, October 12th, 9:00 AM -12:00 PM**, you are invited to participate in the **Symposium on Experimental Economics**.
