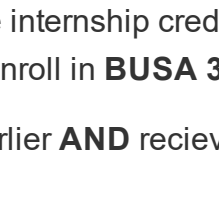

Internships and Co-Ops

Beginning in the Fall 2023 Semester, you can earn academic credit for an internship before **AND** after you're admitted into the Coles College of Business.



If you're in good academic standing (2.0+ GPA), pursuing an internship related to business, but don't qualify yet to receive internship credit from your major-specific internship course, you may be eligible to enroll in **BUSA 3397**.

This means you are now able to complete an internship earlier **AND** receive academic credit for it!

In-Person and Virtual Drop-In Advising:

In-Person Drop-In Advising:

For In-person Drop-Ins, check-in at the front desk with a physical photo ID in Kennesaw Hall Suite 1314 on the Kennesaw Campus. The first available advisor will call you back when it is your turn.

For Virtual Drop-Ins: Call **470-578-6055** to be added to the waitlist for a Teams meeting. You must have your KSU ID number ready. All drop-in sessions are via Microsoft Teams. We do not offer advising over the phone. Please be aware that your meeting may not be immediate. The front desk staff can give you an estimated wait time.

**Drop-in advising is limited. You will meet with the advisor that is available. Drop-in advising is designed for quick questions such as withdrawing from a class or registration errors. Students wanting more in-depth advising such as changing majors, multiple semester degree plans or meeting with a specific advisor should schedule an appointment*

The following topics are unavailable for walk-in advising: Course repeat requests, Study Abroad/Exchanges, Academic Appeals, Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeals, and IS/ISA Plan of Study. Students will need to schedule an appointment to discuss these topics.

Please remember to bring a photo ID to all appointments.
All appointments have a 10-minute grace period.

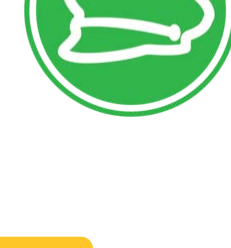

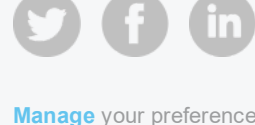
