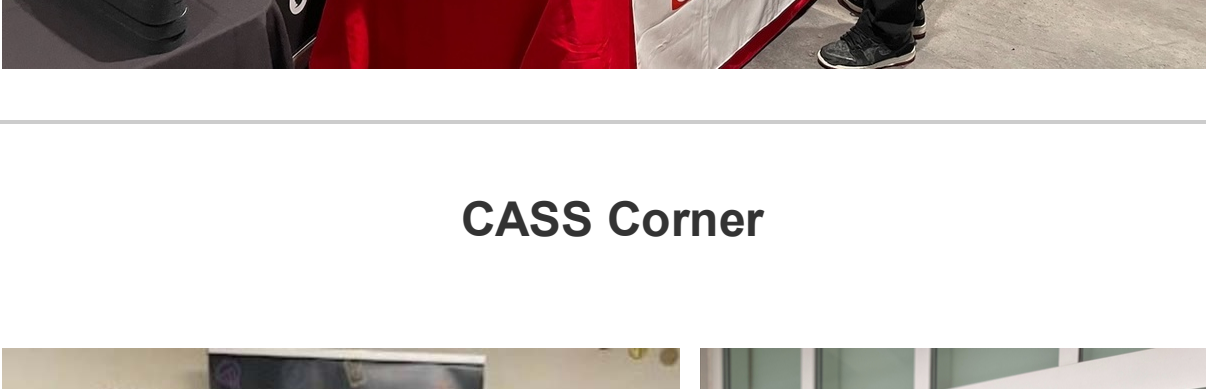

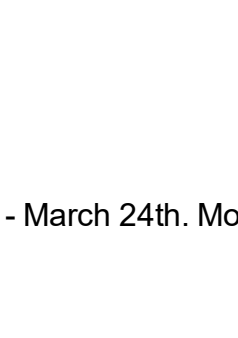

Scheduled appointments will be **NOT** available during those dates. Fully online students who do not wish to come to campus should contact their academic advisor.

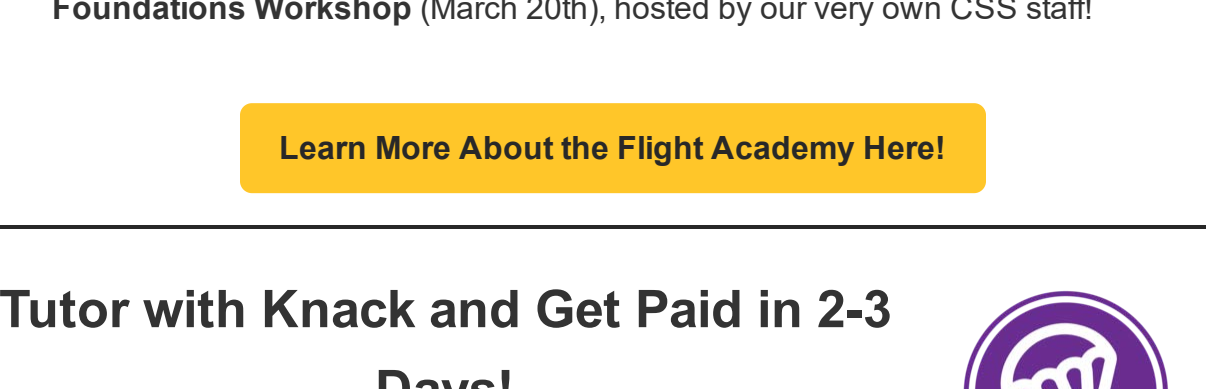

Education Abroad

In order to participate in a Coles College education

abroad program and/or transfer credit to Coles from

another education abroad program, you need to:

1. Be accepted to the Coles Professional Program by the application deadline for the specific Study Abroad program.

2. Meet with your academic advisor in the Center for Student Success (KH 1314) to submit your approval form. Students should generally meet with a Coles College academic advisor early in the process of picking an Education Abroad Program to make sure they are eligible for the program and can use the courses.

3. Complete the KSU Education Abroad Office application process.


