Presented by Coskun Centikaya. An overview of the 72 hour, four year program was presented. it will be funded by external grants and sponsored programs and general market demand was demonstrated.

Jane Brannan had a question about CS8998 and it was confirmed that this is not an actual class but a student will work with a faculty advisor.

M.A. Karim questioned the six hour internship requirement and asked if there is a mechanism in place for sites. it was clarified that there will be a sponsored lab opportunity along with many active external sites who are committed to support the internship requirement. There was another question regarding if journal publications or conference presentations are required. they are not required to graduate an expectations will be decided by the committees. Scott Nowak pointed out that the language makes it sound like it is required and could create confusion. Ethel King-McKenzie Expressed the same concern. The feedback was taken and noted.

Sumit Chakravarty asked about a qualifying exam And how other colleges might be affected. It was clarified that a qualifying exam in year one would occur, and at other colleges would be involved in collaboration whether it's committee members or offering independent studies etc.

Nikki Palomiotis asked if this was a cohort based program. It is not officially a cohort based program but that is the hope for years would be optimal but part time students will take longer.

A motion was made and then rescinded. Amy Jones stated no edits at this level can be made but supplemental information can be added prior to a vote.

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Scott Nowak clarified his opposition stating he felt more concrete information needed to be presented and tighter language needed to appear in the proposal. Ethel King-McKenzie agreed. Discussions continued on whether the proposal should be voted on at the time. It was clarified that the body votes on only on what is in curriculum. Humayun Zafar motioned to end the discussion and move to a vote. Reza Parizi seconded. The majority supported a vote at the time.

Reza Parizi Motion to recommend approval of the whole package. Humayun Zafar seconded. The motion passed with a majority vote.
