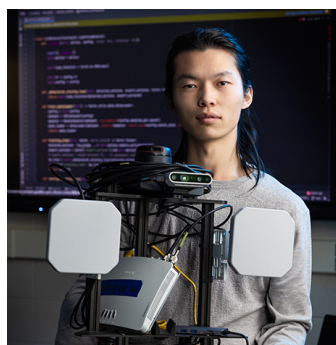


MSIT Student Wins Globecom 2023 Best Paper Award for Groundbreaking IoT Research
