- In the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 the KSU Mock Trial Club was awarded \$4984.88. The Team utilized \$4,324.10 of this funding to register and attend tournaments throughout the Fall and Spring Semester. The Team paid for lodging at three tournaments as well as registration fees for three tournaments. The KSU Mock Trial Club relies on SABAC funding in order to travel for the Fall Semester. Two of these tournaments were in preparation for the AMTA Organized tournaments such as Regionals, ORCS, and Nationals.

Additionally, with the funding awarded to the RSO through SABAC we were able to expand the Club to allow more members to travel and compete against various schools representing KSU. The KSU Mock Trial Club had the

pleasure of being able to accommodate sending 20 members or two Teams to Regionals in the Spring of 2024 using SABAC funding. The KSU Mock Trial Team won first place at Regionals with a perfect score of 8-0 placing against notable schools such as Duke University, University of Georgia, and Florida State University. The RSO strives to provide an inclusive, fun, and educational experience that allows students the opportunities to network with lawyers and law students as well as a chance to visit the Campus of various Law Schools when visiting for tournaments.




